> The campground is all spring fed water filtered and drinkable. There is a Rainwater tank located at our camp kitchens for

filling your water bottles.

TOILETS There are five amenity blocks on our campgrounds. DO NOT

FLUSH anything other than toilet paper down the toilets. This is very important NO tampons, pads or nappies. Please use allocated bins for disposal of these. Our staff provide cleans

daily to the campgrounds between 10am - 2pm.

LAUNDRY There are clotheslines located at each amenity block. Our

> washing machines cost \$6 per cycle. Dryers \$8 per cycle. All machines are coin operated. Our office has change and

washing powder available for \$3.

Fires are allowed at our campgrounds if they are always **FIRES**

> contained. This means all fires must be in a firepit no open fires on lawn. Our office sells firewood for \$25 a bag split.

RECEPTION Groceries and Souvenirs are also available in our office.

disposal fee.
